We are excited to share that Vineyard Junior High has just received the **2023 Schools to Watch Award** from the California League of Educators! We have been named as one of 78 Schools to Watch out of approximately 8000 schools in California. This award is recognized both at the state and national level and would not have been possible without our amazing students, hard work on behalf of our staff, and continued support from the school community. Thus, we share this award with you!

It is hard to believe we are now in our final trimester of the year! Our staff is committed to providing our students with the best education possible to ensure they are ready for the next grade level. Foremost, we want our students to continue to remain focused on their studies and to continue to put forth their personal best in all academic areas. In order to maximize learning, it is important for students to be punctual to school on a daily basis. We have had an increase in tardies and would appreciate your support with ensuring that your child is at school on time each day.

During the month of **April**, your child will be taking the **CAASPP** (California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress) **state test**. All of our students have been participating in taking the Interim Assessments as part of their language arts and math classes to learn strategies to prepare them for the state testing. Students in 8th grade will still take the CAST (California Science Test) the last week in April. Students who earned a 4.0 GPA (grade point average) or a Purple Reign award (PE performance award) for trimester two will be invited to attend a ceremony in the MPR on March 14 (7th grade) and March 15 (8th grade) from 7:30 - 8:00 am. All students who are eligible for CJSF (California Junior Scholarship Federation) can sign up during lunchtime at the student store from March 7 - 17.

Please join us for our annual **Open House** on **March 23 from 6:00 - 7:00 pm.** Parents will have the opportunity to visit their child's classrooms and teachers to see all of the wonderful learning taking place. We hope to see you there! Please join us for our Band, Orchestra, and Choral Spring Concert which will be held on May 11 from 5:00 - 7:00 pm.

As we prepare for the upcoming year, we will need all 7th grade parents/guardians to update their information in our Infinite Campus Parent Portal between **July 1 - 14, 2023**. In order for your child to receive their schedule at **schedule pick-up on July 26th**, your online Infinite Campus portal information must be completed and approved.




