

Alta Loma School District Employee COVID-19 Protocols

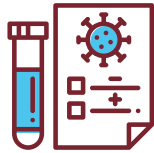
If you have tested positive for COVID, or are experiencing 1 or more symptoms consistent with COVID-19, do not report to work. Notify your direct supervisor and complete the Employee Self-Reporting Form. You will be contacted by Risk Management.

Staff Who Test Positive For COVID-19:

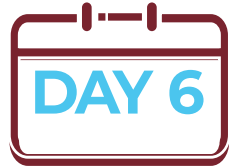
Regardless of Vaccination Status, Previous Infection or Lack Of Symptoms



Stay home
for 5 days



Test for COVID
on day 5
or after.



Return to work on
day 6 (or after) if:
no symptoms (or resolving)
AND negative test dated
day 5 or after.



Wear a mask around
others at work when
indoors and outdoors
for remainder of 10
day isolation period.



Without a test, isolation
ends after 10 days if there
are no symptoms or
symptoms are resolving.
No negative test needed
to return to work.

Staff who have come into close contact with a COVID-19 case:

Wear a mask for 10 days
when around others in
all settings



Watch for
symptoms



Test for COVID within
3-5 days after last
exposure

If you test positive: See
the "Staff Who Test
Positive For COVID-19"
section on this form.

If symptoms begin:
Isolate, get tested, and
notify Risk
Management.

Employees
experiencing 1 or
more symptoms
consistent with
COVID-19 with no
known COVID positive
exposure:

Employee can return to
work after 24 hours have
passed with symptoms
improving and if no new
symptoms have developed.

AND

Obtain and submit a
negative COVID test to Risk
Management.

OR

Obtain and submit an
alternate diagnosis from a
medical provider.
