

## Alta Loma School District COVID Case Counts

As of January 1, 2021, we are required to report COVID Case Counts. The Alta Loma School District is committed to providing accurate and transparent information regarding active COVID-19 cases on our campuses, while also maintaining privacy and confidentiality for our students and staff. The information below represents the number of confirmed active COVID-19 cases among District students and staff on our campuses (In-Person instruction only). This information is as of January 4, 2021, the day school operations began following Winter Break. This data will be updated regularly and as cases are confirmed. In the event of a positive case, school communities are notified directly by their principals.

*\*Confirmed cases of staff only include staff members who were working on campus when they were exposed, symptomatic, and/or tested positive. The cases do not include a staff member who has not been on campus for the period which they were exposed and/or tested positive. For instance, if a staff member who has been working from home tests positive, yet has not been on campus for several weeks, he/she would not be included in the totals, as they posed no risk to students or other staff members.*

## **Communication Process in the Event of Positive Cases**

In the event there is a positive case on campus, the affected individual(s) will be contacted directly by their school principals or staff and they will receive a letter that may include self-isolation directions and other important information. Families of students who are not affected will not receive a notification letter and no action will be required. School principals or school staff will communicate new cases directly to their school communities. Please note that our District will only communicate and provide data for active confirmed COVID-19 cases.

## **ALSD COVID-19 Reporting Instructions for Families**

If your student(s) is suspected or confirmed to have COVID-19, it must be reported to your school office. ALSD schools and staff will maintain confidentiality and protect student privacy, following all [FERPA protocols](#).

## **What Families Can Do to Limit the Spread**

In addition to health and safety measures taken on our campuses, we encourage families to be proactive and to reinforce the importance of hand-washing, physical distancing and face masks to limit the spread of the coronavirus. If a member of your household tests positive for COVID-19 or is awaiting test results, please keep your child at home and notify your school. Additionally, if your child has symptoms of COVID-19, please make sure they stay home and get tested if necessary.

Anyone with symptoms consistent with COVID-19 should remain at home in isolation for a minimum of 10 days plus at least 24 hours after the resolution of fever (without fever-reducing medication) and improvement of other symptoms. A doctor's note may be required to return to school. Finally, keep children home when they are sick. Schools will work with students and families to maintain confidentiality and to help continue your student's education.
