The Alta Loma Long Term Independent Study Program is an **optional** alternative program for eligible students whose needs may be best met through study outside of the regular classroom setting. ALLTIS offers students in grades k-8 a flexible, independent alternative to the traditional classroom-based learning experience.

The ALLTIS Program will offer:

- Daily instruction provided by a certificated instructor in all subjects
- Ongoing check-ins throughout the week
- Required services such as English Language Development will continue to be provided through the Alta Loma School District
- Instructional units equivalent in quality and quantity to classroom instruction and that are aligned to State standards
- Course of study on a similar schedule as students in the traditional classrooms
- District benchmark assessments and State summative assessments for progress monitoring
- Support provided to parent/guardians

The Alta Loma School District's Long Term Independent Study Program (ALLTIS) is a partnership between family and teacher:

- Parent/Guardian is the learning coach who supports their child by creating a workspace that is free of distractions, establishes a weekly learning schedule, monitors course work completion, demonstrates problems, explains concepts, and ensures their child understands course content.
- Teacher provides educational support and feedback through daily synchronous interactions, meetings during online sessions, and/or check-ins by email or phone
- Teacher administers District assessments and consults with families
- For students in Special Education, the IEP team must hold a meeting prior to enrollment to determine if Independent Study is appropriate
- ALSD offers a District provided Chromebook and/or wifi adaptor on loan for the duration of the student's participation in the program, upon request
- Parents may enroll their student at any time throughout the school year
- Individual meetings are available upon request. The ALSD highly recommends that all parents/guardians attend both the Parent Orientation and the Parent Information Night listed below

- In-Person Parent Information night 8/5/2021 at the ALSD District Support Center
