

Grades 3-6 Options for Reopening Classrooms

<p><u>Distance Learning Model</u></p> <p>(5 days per week)</p>	<p>The Distance Learning Model for grades 3-6 will continue to be available to students five days a week. However, there may be some change to the routines. Teachers will continue to follow state standards and teach through the Google Classroom while simultaneously teaching students in-person. Pick-up and drop-off opportunities for supplies and transfer of student work will continue to take place at school sites.</p> <p>Additional Information:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Your child’s teacher will not change. ● Your child’s learning schedule will be the same. ● Daily attendance in Google Meet is required and independent work will be provided.
<p><u>Hybrid Model</u></p> <p>(In-Person Learning and Distance Learning)</p>	<p>Students will attend school on Mondays through Distance Learning with their class peers, as they have been doing. Two days a week, either T/TH or W/F, students will attend school for in-person instruction for the school day. The other two days a week, students will participate in their classroom remotely. Independent work will be provided for additional practice at home. On the two days students attend school in-person, they will participate in a daily health screening, including a temperature check, before they enter school. Students will be expected to wear a mask.</p> <p>Additional Information:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Your child’s teacher will not change. ● All students will participate in Distance Learning on Mondays following the current schedule. ● Your child will be assigned to T/TH or W/F alphabetically by last name, and you will be notified by your school as to your assigned days. ● Students will follow the schedule below whether in-person or learning remotely on Tuesday through Friday. ● In-person class size is a smaller group to accommodate social distancing. ● Students and staff must remain at home if they are sick. ● Recess will be limited to activities not using playground equipment. ● School lunch will be available and students will eat lunch at school. ● Child Care (fee-based) is available. ● On-Campus safety precautions include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Students and staff will have their temperatures checked prior to entering. ✓ Safety and hygiene routines will be taught and practiced. ✓ Campus access will be limited to those providing essential functions at school. (Unfortunately, schools cannot accommodate volunteers.) ✓ Desks and high-touch surfaces will be cleaned and disinfected during the transitions between classes and at the end of the day. ✓ Students will be required to wear masks while at school.
